Dayton, OH, January 25, 2007 – Dayton based CompuNet Clinical Laboratories will soon open a new Patient Service Center in Urbana. The facility, located at 848 Scioto St., Suite 1A will offer convenience for patients who previously traveled to Springfield to have their lab work performed.

CompuNet partners with nearly all insurance plans, including Medicare and Medicaid, and patients can pay at the time of service if they do not have insurance coverage. Checks, money orders, and credit card payments are accepted.
